Earlier today we were visited by 5 police officers and two squad cars as part of the emergency service public outreach programme. Our students were thrilled to listen to the officers' presentation on the duties of the police force and even happier to explore the squad cars and try out some of the police equipment. Please note that we have decided to change our recommended school bus provider from NewGen to RushOwl from the beginning of Term 3 (6th January). The main reasons for this change are that RushOwl has a much newer fleet of vehicles and added safety features including onboard CCTV and location tracking through their App. Please read the flyer on the next page which outlines further details of their service, including how to register for the second online information session scheduled for later today (15th of November). Please note that this change of preferred provider will not increase the bus charges this academic year.


