Dear Parents/Guardians,

It's already the end of our third full week, throughout which we continued to see excellent levels of student attendance, allowing us to move quickly through curriculum content. At the beginning of this week, we welcomed our visitors from Larrakeyah Primary School, Australia. The Larrakeyah students and Invictus students have been working collaboratively on projects for over a year, which culminated in artwork presented to the High Commissioner, Mr. Allaster Cox, at the Australian High Commission on Wednesday of this week. During our visit, students from both schools were given a presentation on the work of the High Commission and how this work significantly benefits both Singapore and Australia. The commissioner later took questions from students from both schools for almost an hour, as we learned what it's like to be a High Commissioner.

On Thursday of this week our Year 6 students visited the zoo with the Larrakeyah students, visiting the seals, butterfly enclosure, bird sanctuary, kidzone, and various animal enclosures. Concurrently throughout the week, our Bollywood dancers have been rehearsing their performance which was professionally recorded today by a videographer and will be shared in the coming weeks. We hope our relationship with Larrakeyah Primary School continues to flourish and that Invictus Bukit Timah students will take up the invitation to visit Australia in the near future. For now our Larrakeyah friends are preparing to fly back to Australia early tomorrow morning and we wish them a swift and safe journey home.
